March Meeting Recap: Incubating Business Downtown

Jim Miller, Executive Director of the Nucleus Retail Incubator, and Jessica Weaver, Nucleus board member and architect at Shive Hattery Engineering, described the unique community partnership created to encourage homegrown retail businesses in downtown Cedar Rapids. Spurred by the devastating loss of the Osco Drug Store on Second Avenue in the fall of 2004, the non-profit Nucleus Retail Incubator was conceived as a way to help fill the need for services such as a pharmacy and market in the downtown area while encouraging businesses to locate and thrive there.

With design services donated by Shive Hattery, the former Osco Building was remodeled into an "attractive, cool and chique" retail center with spaces for nine businesses, chosen based on their perceived viability for success in the downtown arena. Each business is coached and supported by the Nucleus Incubator staff. With six of the nine spaces

occupied as of mid-March, the Retail Incubator is off to a promising start. Stop by and check out the new shops that are
