February Meeting Recap: Update Your PR Bag of Tricks

Kareem Smith, Minneapolis-based Senior Account Manager for PR Newswire, joined us in February to talk about tools of the PR trade in the digital age. Citing surveys showing that 98 percent of journalists go on-line daily and 92 percent of them conduct research on-line, Smith emphasized the importance of getting your news releases on-line – in places where search engines will find them.

He recommended the use of search engine optimization tools such as news services to increase the visibility and longevity of your releases. Also critical is the use of key words highlighting information people look for when researching your type of product or service. Other on-line tools include multimedia news releases that feature text plus audio, video, photos, downloads and other links – in effect creating on-line press kits with complete, up-to-date information about an organization or product.
