May Meeting Recap: Good Writing in the Age of Instant Messaging

It can be done, said Rockwell Senior Technical Writer Charles Crawley, our May speaker. Charles cautioned us about writing pitfalls common in today's fast-paced, tech-based environment, including the perils of recycling text, over-reliance on tools like Spell-check and Grammar-check, and failure to consider what your audience knows about your topic. His advice: Print out your text (reading comprehension is better from printed copy than copy on a computer screen) and proof it carefully, use a first-rate dictionary and work to improve your spelling, learn to love your own writing, read more and better sources (good reading and good writing are two sides of the same coin), and, above all, remember to write with your readers in mind. – Sher Jasperse
