April Meeting Recap: Celebrating and Preserving Our State's Cultural Heritage

Joe Nolte, Director of Statewide Operations for the African-American Historical Museum and Cultural Center of Iowa, graciously stepped in to take the place of not one, but two scheduled speakers who were unable to appear at our April meeting, sharing highlights of the exciting work being accomplished by the museum and its supporters.

African-Americans were part of the state of Iowa from day one, Joe explained, with several large African-American settlements established in Iowa in conjunction with the mining industry during the last half of the 19th century. One of them, the town of Buxton in southeast Iowa, was known as "the black man's utopia" because of its thriving community of professional and middle class African-Americans. Working from its headquarters in the beautiful new Cedar Rapids museum building, the African-American Historical Museum and Cultural Center of Iowa is reaching out to encourage preservation efforts across the state, currently developing a chapter program and organizing an African-American Women's Leadership Conference.
