
January Meeting Recap: The Brave New World of DesignDriven Marketing

A CRPRA record crowd of nearly 60 people gathered for our January meeting to hear Stamats Communications Creative Director Fritz McDonald address the topic of "Cutting-Edge Design: Reshaping the World." McDonald suggested that traditional advertising techniques and agencies are on the road to extinction, with a new design-driven approach redefining what they do. In this "co-creation culture" where customers share ownership of the advertising and marketing approach, the design imperative is transforming everything from restaurants and airlines to popular gadgets (e.g. the I-POD). Related trends include the use of more humor, product design (e.g. high-design Target vs. generic Wal-Mart), political and social ads, and environmental marketing that incorporates four-dimensional and interactive elements. - Sher Jasperse
